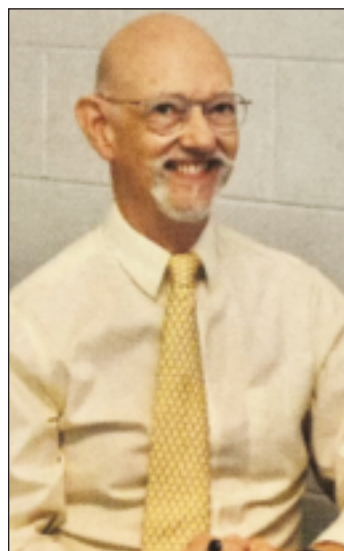
Legends Retire

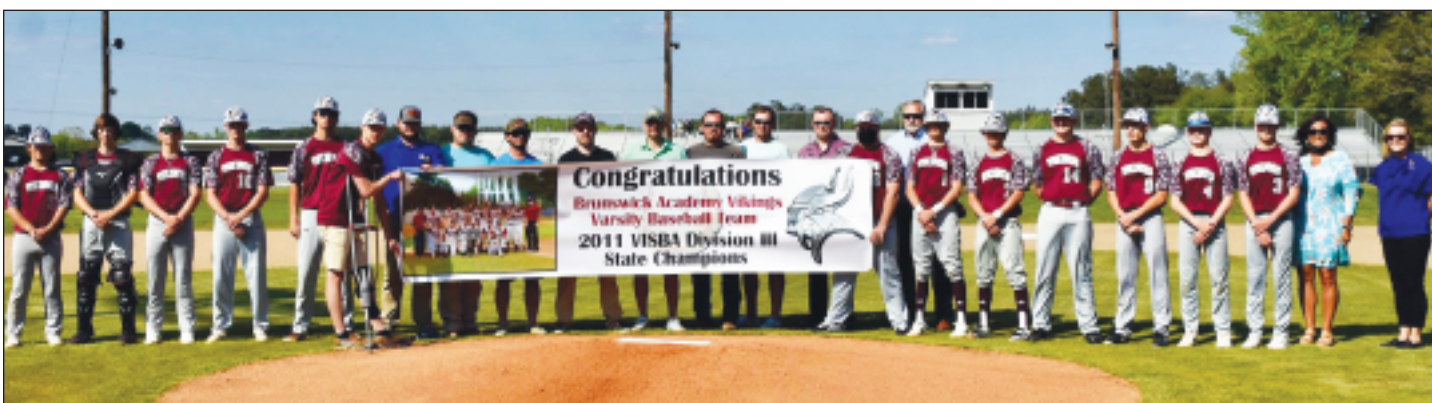
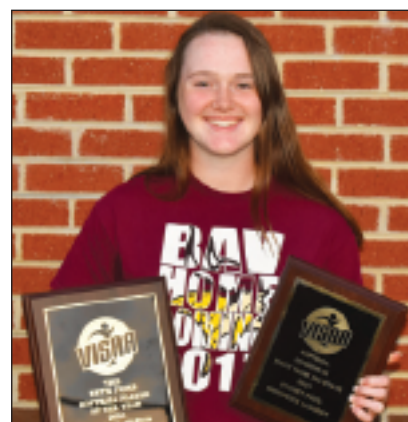
Felhauer Receives Football Awards
